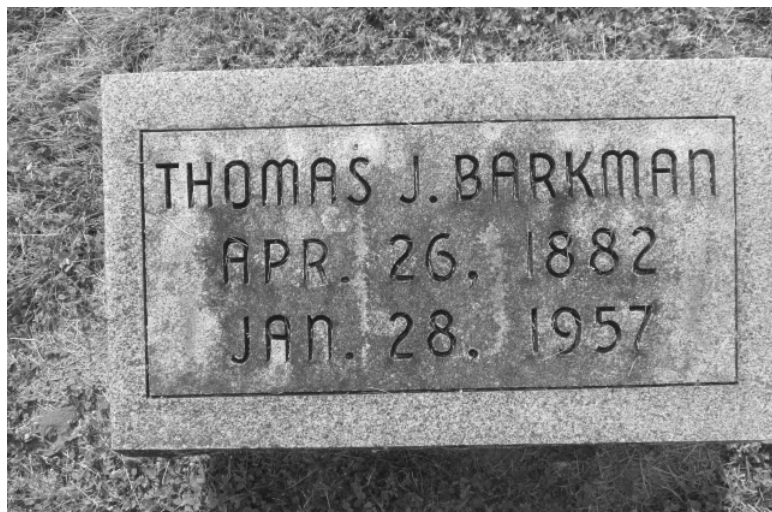

Thomas J. Barkman Dies After Long Illness

Thomas J. Barkman, 74, Ewing, died at 2:45 a.m. Monday morning at the Roselawn Annex Nursing Home in Seymour, where he has lived since last March following a lingering illness of two years.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Wednesday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home in Brownstown, with the Rev. Gene Dulin of the Brownstown Christian Church in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mr. Barkman was born near Vallonia on April 26, 1882, the son of the late John Henry and Julima Bland Berkman, and was a life-long resident of Jackson county.
