## ZULINA BARKMAN TAKEN BY DEATH

**Aged Widow Succumbs to  
Cancer at Home of Daugh-  
ter Near Taylorsville.**

Mrs. Zulina Barkman, 81, widow of John H. Barkman, died this morning at 9:30 o'clock at the home of her daughter, Mrs. William Doup, south of Taylorsville, where she had been making her home for about a year. Her death followed a long illness due to cancer.

Mrs. Barkman was born and reared in Jackson county and spent the greater part of her life at Brownstown. Two years she lived in Hutchins, Kansas, but later returned to Brownstown and remained there until coming to the home of Mrs. Doup. She was a member of the Christian church and was a well-liked woman.

### **Funeral at Brownstown.**

Her husband died several years ago. Surviving besides Mrs. Doup, are another daughter, Mrs. G. H. Beldon, of Indianapolis, and four sons, Thomas and C. H. Barkman, of Brownstown; V. E. Barkman, of San Diego, Calif., and William Barkman, of Brockton, Ill. There are also six grand-children, one great-grandchild and a brother, William T. Bland, of Brownstown.

The remains will be taken to Brownstown for burial but funeral arrangements will not be made pending word from relatives in other cities.
