BOOFER—Michael Boofer, aged about 70 years, died at his home in Brownstown Thursday, November 17, 1910, after about three week's sickness of asthma and heart trouble. Deceased was a veteran of the Civil War, being a member of Co. C 145th Ind. Vols. He was united in marriage to Lizzie Boling in 1868. To their union were born eight children, five of whom are living viz: Mrs. Byford Jarvis, John and James Boofer, of this place; Wm. Boofer of near Bedford, and Mrs. Harry Reynolds, of Madison. His first wife preceded him to the grave several years ago. He was again married about eight years ago to Amanda Lockhart, who with the children are left to mourn the loss of a faithful husband, and a loving father. The funeral services were conducted Saturday at 12 o'clock by Rev. Jessie Nichols, followed by interment in Fairview cemetery.
