Mary E. Boyatt was born in Ohio, February 18, 1843. She was married to W. L. Boyatt January 30th, 1873. She was the mother of five children, Edwin, Daisy, Ida, Lena and Anna, who are still living.

Mrs. Boyatt was an obedient wife, kind and loving mother and model neighbor. Kind and gentle, she won the respect of all with whom she mingled and will long be remembered by her many acts of kindness. In the home circle she was kind and cheerful, ruling with a hand of love.

She had been afflicted for years, but all her sufferings were borne with a Christian heroism and fortitude. Her last fatal illness was of short duration, lasting but about one week.

In the death of Mrs. Boyatt the husband has lost a loving companion, the children a loving parent and the neighbors an excellent friend; but when death comes no earthly power can stay his hand and the one we could least spare is taken, and tears of sorrow cannot avail. Again has the grim Messenger entered one of our homes and called the mother away; again does the husband lose a companion and the children are left motherless.

The funeral services took place Friday, March 20, 1891, conducted by Rev. W. N. Fletcher in the M. E. Church, after which the remains were laid away in the New Cemetery at Brownstown.
