

MISS FLORENCE BRODHECKER, died Friday, April 10. 1903, aged 17 years, 4 months and 28 days. The cause of her death was consumption, which probably resulted from an attack of scarlet fever. The funeral services were conducted at the Presbyterian church, Sunday morning, at 10 o'clock, Rev. Luther J. Emerson officiating, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.

Florence was the youngest daughter of Frank and Mary A. Brodhecker, and was born in Brownstown, November 17, 1885. She was of a quiet and pleasing disposition and held in high esteem by her friends and her associates. She bore her lingering illness with remarkable patience for one so young in years, never murmering or complaining of her affliction. Loving hands ministered to her every want as her young life faded away and until the last spark had died out, but could not stay the ruthless hand of death. She was a member of the Presbyterian church and choir and a regular attendant at Sunday School from early childhood.

Besides the parents, two sisters and three brothers survive her, who have the sincere and heartfelt sympathy of many friends in their bereavement.
