Prof. J. C. Browning, after a sickness of about a year with consumption, died Friday morning, October 23, 1896, at the home of his father-in-law, W. H. Ewing, of Ewing, aged some thirty-seven years. He was a son of Nathan B. Browning, near Freetown, where he was born and raised. For several years he has been engaged in teaching and was a popular instructor. He was an honorable, upright citizen. A wife and one child survive. Funeral at 10 o'clock to-morrow forenoon from the courthouse at Brownstown. Religious services by Rev. John Braselton, of North Vernon, assisted by Rev. Thompson, of Brownstown.
