Lists Of Deaths Not Reported In The Items From Our Regular Correspondents.

**BULTMAN**—John H. Bultman, one of Brownstown's highly respected citizens, passed away at his home at this place this morning at 4 o'clock. Deceased has been in failing health for some time, but had been confined to his bed only since Monday, when he was taken suddenly worse. The immediate cause of his death was uraemic poisoning.

He was a son of Mr. and Mrs. J. H. Bultman, both deceased, and was born in Brownstown township March 3, 1860, and at the time of his death was 57 years and two months of age. He was united in marriage to Miss Carrie Marquart in 1900, who preceded him to the grave January 11, 1917.

Deceased was a farmer by occupation but retired from active work several years ago on account of failing health. He was appointed assessor of Brownstown this spring but resigned this position, about two weeks ago. He was of kind and generous disposition, always ready and willing to assist anyone in need.

He is survived by one brother, Wm., of Missouri, and four sisters, Mrs. Rhoda Strodman, of Winfield, Kan.; Mrs. Hannah Brown, of Versailles, Ky., Miss Nancy Bultman, of Brownstown township, and Mrs. Alvira Sewell of this place.

The funeral services will be conducted at the Methodist church, of which he was a member, Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock by Rev. C. H. Pinnick, assisted by Rev. W. U. Guerrant and Rev. Frank Reynolds, after which the remains will be interred in Fairview cemetery.
