Dies Of Injuries Sustained In Fall

Mrs. Mary Belle Burrell, 89, Suffered Broken Hip January 8
---Other Deaths.

Mrs. Mary Belle Burrell, age 89 years, passed away at the St. Vincent hospital, Indianapolis, Tuesday night. Death resulted from injuries she sustained when she fell and fractured her hip January 8.

Funeral services will be conducted at the Wallace Funeral Home in Brownstown Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery. Friends may call at the Funeral Home where the body will lie in state.

Mrs. Burrell was born December 27, 1851, at Cincinnati, Ohio, to the late Thomas Miles and Jane R. Snodgrass Craft, pioneer residents of Vallonia, where she spent her girlhood days. She was married at Vallonia December 27, 1869, to Frank Burrell. To their union were born three sons and three daughters, of whom two, Harry and Nettie Burrell Shirley, preceded her in death.

Mr. Burrell served as clerk of Jackson county two terms. Later the family moved to Kokomo, where Mr. Burrell died a number of years ago. For some time Mrs. Burrell has made her home in Indianapolis with her youngest daughter, Mrs. Mary Parker. She was a most estimable woman and was beloved and honored by all who knew her. She was a member of the Presbyterian church.

Besides Mrs. Parker she is survived by three other children, Herbert and Howard Burrell and Mrs. Cora Miller, all of Kokomo; a sister, Mrs. Luella C. Bland, of Brownstown; six grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
