FARMER DROPS DEAD IN FIELD

Wm. Teimeyer Expires While Sowing Oats

William Teimeyer, a well known citizen of Washington township, dropped dead in a field about 4:30 o'clock Tuesday evening.

He lives about six miles southwest of Brownstown near Sauers, and was sowing oats on Henry Brand's farm about a mile from home. Two of his boys were working with him in the field, but some distance from him, when they saw their father fall. They ran to him but life was practically gone when they reached his side. Some other men working on adjoining farms were called and Mr. Teimeyer's remains were conveyed to his home. Coroner Dowden was sent for and went out this morning to hold an inquest.

Mr. Teimeyer was about 45 years of age. He leaves a wife and several children.

The funeral services will be conducted at the family residence Thursday morning at 10 o'clock. Rev. J. H. Weaver, pastor of the Presbyterian church at this place officiating, after which the remains will be brought to Brownstown and laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.
