**Weathers** — James Hutchinson Weathers, who has been in failing health with palsley for nine years, passed away at the home of his son, Raymond Weathers, at Benton, Illinois, Friday morning at 1:30 o'clock age 66 years, 6 months and 28 days. Death was due to a complication of diseases.

Mr. Weathers was a life-long resident of Jackson county. He was born to Isaac William and Sarah Jane Weathers in Brownstown September 9, 1866. He was married to Miss Nina Cartwright, who survives.

Mr. and Mrs. Weathers went to Illinois in November to spend the winter with their son and he gradually grew worse while there. He was a member of the Methodist church.

Besides his wife he leaves six children, Mrs. Sarah Cox and Mrs. C. W. McAlpine, of Chicago; Jesse C. Weathers, of Pittsburgh, Pa.; Raymond, of Benton, Ill.; Mrs. Glenn McCrary of Peru; Wm. A.
