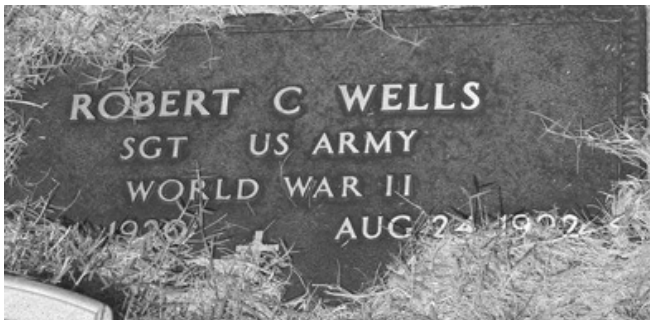

Robert C. Wells rites Thursday

Robert C. Wells, 72, of Brownstown died Monday afternoon at his cabin along the White River near Brownstown.

The self-employed metals processor was a member of Brownstown United Methodist Church. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II.

Born Feb. 21, 1920, in Rensselaer, he was a son of Simeon and Pearl Watson Wells. He married Anne Morrone on Feb. 8, 1946, in Hobart. She survives.
