WELLS—Died, Thursday evening, July 17, 1913, Mrs. Sarah M. Wells, wife of our esteemed fellow-citizen, E. M. Wells, after a lingering illness of cancer of the stomach, aged 74 years, three months and ten days.

Deceased was a native of Washington county, Virginia, where she was born April 7, 1839. She came to Brownstown with relatives in 1863. She was united in marriage to E. Marion Wells, August 23, 1868, and to their union were born two sons, both dying in infancy. She was the last of a family of four boys and one girl to be called to her reward. After her marriage she and her husband moved to Missouri, where they resided five years, returning to Brownstown and she continuously made this place her home until her death.

Mrs. Wells united with the Baptist church in 1877 and remained a devout member thereof until her death. She was a most estimable lady. To her duty was first, whether to her church, her husband or her friends. She departed leaving behind her a beautiful life, having always been noted for kindness of heart and readiness to help the needy in sickness and distress. Her death will not only be mourned by her husband, but by all who knew her.

The funeral services were conducted at the Baptist church Sunday morning at 9:30 o'clock, Rev. H. H. Elmore officiating, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.
