Ervin G. Wheeler, 77, Brownstown, died at 11:55 p.m. Saturday, July 10, 2004, at his residence.

Mr. Wheeler attended the Brownstown Church of the Nazarene. He retired from L.P. Cavett Co., where he was employed for 30 years as a bituminous mixer. He was a 51-year member of the International Union of Operating Engineers. He lived most of his life in Washington and Jackson counties.
