Gerald E. Wheeler, 56, Seymour, died at 6 p.m. Wednesday, April 10, at Jewish Hospital, Louisville, Ky.

He was a truck driver.

Funeral will begin at 1 p.m. today, Saturday, April 13, at Johnson Funeral Home, Vallonia, with the Rev. Albert Temple officiating. Burial will be at Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mr. Wheeler was born July 26, 1928, at Osborn, Ohio, to the late James Wheeler and to Orpha Harris Wheeler, who survives. He lived most of his life in Ohio. He was formerly married to Beulah Lambert and was engaged to marry Marie Lucas of Columbus, and both survive.
