Melvin Wheeler, Cortland Native, Dies At Capital—Buried At Cemetery Here

Funeral rites were held Saturday morning from the Flanner & Buchanan Funeral Home in Indianapolis, followed by burial in Fairview Cemetery here for Melvin Wheeler, native of Cortland, and husband of the former Miss Ruth Durment, of Brownstown.

Mr. Wheeler, who lived at 8500 North Meridian street, Indianapolis, died suddenly Wednesday of last week.

He was the son of the late Jacob and Hannah Meyer Wheeler and was born in Hamilton township, near Cortland, January 12, 1894. He and Mrs. Wheeler were married August 21, 1918, in Alexandria, Virginia. Mrs. Wheeler is a sister-in-law of Mrs. Bess Durment, of Brownstown.
