## Retired Lumberman Dies At Vallonia Home

Tom Wheeler, 80, died at 8:45 p. m. Tuesday at his home in Vallonia. He had been ill for some time.

A retired sawmill owner and lumber dealer, he had moved to Vallonia on his retirement in 1948. Previously, he lived and worked in Brownstown from 1940 to 1948 after beginning his business in Washington County.

Funeral services will be conducted Friday at 1:30 p. m. from the Johnson Funeral Home in Vallonia with burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Born May 5, 1885, in Washington County, he was the son of George and Mary Davis Wheeler, both deceased.

A son, Herbert Wheeler, was killed in World War II and a daughter, Lucy Wheeler, and two sisters, also preceded him in death.

In 1905, he was married to the former Mattie P. Harris, who survives.
