Flossie Wille, 91, of Martinsville and formerly of Columbus, died at 6:45 p.m. Monday, March 27, 2000, at Grandview Convalescent Center at Martinsville.

Mrs. Wille was a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Columbus. She and her husband operated the Puritan Cafe in Seymour from 1941 to 1946 and operated Wille's Food Shop on Fifth Street in Columbus from 1949 to 1965.

Born Feb. 2, 1909, in Clay County, Ky., she was a daughter of Luther and Sarah Menton Davidson. On April 19, 1930, at Toledo, Ohio, she married August "Gus" Wille, who died Dec. 21, 1988.

Survivors include a daughter, Shirley Rogers, Columbus; a son, Naverne Wille, Martinsville; four grandchildren;
