WILSON—Ephriam Wilson died at his home at this place Sunday evening, January 31, 1915, at four o'clock, aged 68 years, ten months and 2 days.

Deceased was born in Jackson county March 29, 1846. He was united in marriage to Louisa J. Alexander about 48 years ago. He was a veteran of the civil war and was a member of Co. G, 54th Regt. and also of Co. C, 137th Regt. He was a member of the Christian church, but owing to his affliction was not able to attend. For a number of years he was a stock buyer and is well known all over the county. He was of a quiet disposition and had many friends.

Besides his widow he is survived by five children, Mrs. Minnie Eisel, Orland, Dillard, Willard and Pirtle Wilson. He also leaves four brothers and one sister, Tip Wilson, of this place; Sam, of Kurtz; John, of Pike county, and Mrs. Sarah Emmons, of near Clearspring.

The funeral services were conducted at the residence Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock by Rev. T. J. Due, followed by interment in Fairview cemetery.
