## Frederick E. Wilson, Father Of Mrs. Mantz, Dies In Illinois

Funeral rites were held this afternoon from the Zabel Funeral Home, here, for Frederick E. Wilson, 64, father of Mrs. Orville Mantz and a brother of Mrs. Clyde Wilson, of Brownstown.

For several years a Brownstown resident, Mr. Wilson died at noon Sunday in the Veterans' Hospital in Downey, Illinois.

Ill for thirty years, Mr. Wilson had been in veterans hospitals a greater part of that time and had been in the hospital at Downey, for about a year.

He was born in Louisville, Illinois, February 21, 1897, a son of the late Oscar and Mary Keeterson Wilson. He was married in Indianapolis, October, 1922, to Edith Thomas, who survives.

A veteran of World War I, he was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church and Camp Jackson Post No. 112, American Legion, when a resident of Brownstown.

Surviving in addition to the widow, the daughter and sister, is a grandchild. A brother and sister are deceased.

The Rev. William Bateman, pastor of the Brownstown Baptist Church, was in charge of the funeral rites. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery.
