Wilson—Orland C. Wilson, age 68, died at his home in Brownstown last Wednesday night at 8:30 o'clock. Death was due to complications with which he had been ill for about two years, but he had only been seriously

ill six weeks.

Funeral services were conducted at the Christian church, of which he was a member, Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock in charge of the Rev. O. S. Brooke. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

Mr. Wilson was born in Brownstown July 17, 1872, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Ephriam Wilson, both deceased, and spent the greater part of his life here. He operated a meat market here at different times, also at Medora and Bedford. He moved back here from Bedford three years ago and operated a meat market at the West End.

He was married to Kate Moreland, who preceded him in death. On July 4, 1906, he was married at Nashville, Brown county, to Rebecca Cummings, who survives.

Besides the widow he is survived by one son, Hubert E. Wilson, of Cincinnati, by the first marriage; a daughter, Mrs. Lillian Burnett, of Bedford; six grandchildren; three brothers, Willard, Dillard and Pirtle Wilson, and a sister, Mrs. Minnie Eisel, all of Brownstown.
