Mrs. Freeda M. Winter, 85, of 131 S. Poplar St., Brownstown, died Tuesday, Oct. 19, at Huron Lodge, Ann Arbor, Michigan. She had been in failing health for two years, but death was unexpected.

Mrs. Winter was born Nov. 24, 1890, in Garner, Iowa, to the late J.W.S. and Addie Wacker Mercer. In 1921 she married O.W. Winter, who preceded her in death several years ago.

Mrs. Winter attended the State University of Iowa and Indiana University at Bloomington. She taught in high school at Brownstown until her marriage and then moved to Chicago and taught there. After the death of her husband 10 years ago, she returned to Brownstown to be with her sister.

Mrs. Winter was a member of the Brownstown United Methodist Church and had been active in Red Cross work and other organizations in the Chicago area, where she and her husband lived for 50 years.

Survivors include a sister, Mrs. Lillie McMillan, of Brownstown; a daughter, Mrs. A.A. (Jean) Campbell, of Ann Arbor, Mich.; three grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren. One son preceded her in death.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Friday, Oct. 22, from the Spurgeon Funeral Home in Brownstown with the Rev. Robert Riggs, of the Brownstown United Methodist Church, officiating. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery.
