Olice Winters Dies³, 23 Suddenly at Chicago

Olice Winters, Chicago, died suddenly of a heart attack Tuesday morning at the Wesley Memorial Hospital, Chicago. He was 58 years of age.

Mr. Winters was a native of Posey county, having been born at Posieville in 1889. In 1911 he married Freeda Mercer, of Brownstown, who survives. For many years Mr. Winter had been principal of the Lakeview High School in Chicago. He was a graduate of Indiana University. He was a member of the Methodist Church.

Surviving Mr. Winters, in addition to his widow, are a daughter, Mrs. Gene Campbell, Ann Arbor, Mich.; a brother, Dr. Matthew Winter, Indianapolis; and two grandchildren. A son, William Leslie Winter, 21, died as the result of an automobile accident recently.
