Carl Randolph "Tip" Woodmansee, 89, of Brownstown, died at 6:50 a.m. Tuesday, Oct. 3, 2000, at Memorial Hospital, Seymour. He had been ill for three weeks.

A member of the Brownstown Baptist Church, he had retired from Kleffer Paper Mill in 1983. He had served on the Brownstown Volunteer Fire Department for many years. He had been a lifetime Jackson County resident.
