WOODMANSEE—Died at her home in Indianapolis, Monday morning, October 23, 1910, Miss Celestus Woodmansee, youngest daughter of Mrs. Wm. G. Woodmansee, of tuberculosis, of which she had been a suffer for a long time. Deceased was born in Brownstown June 22, 1888, and at the time of her death was 22 years, 4 months and 2 days of age. She moved to Indianapolis with her parents about ten years ago. Her father preceded her to the grave about three years ago.

Though never physically strong, she never failed in loving service to those who appealed to her tender heart, whether to her family or to her friends. Her sweet and gentle life cannot but leave a benediction and inspiration to all those who came under her influence. Besides her mother she is survived by two sisters and two brothers, viz: Mrs. Harry Clements, of Mitchell; Mrs. Harry Crane, of Tulsa, Okla. Howard, of near Chicago, and Abe, who resides at home.

The remains were brought here this morning and the funeral services were conducted at the Baptist church this afternoon at one o'clock by the pastor of the Baptist church to which she belonged at Indianapolis, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.
