**Woodmansee**—Winfield Scott Woodmansee passed away at the home of his daughter, Mrs. G. F. Schwein, one-half mile east of Brownstown, Thursday morning, February 23, at 3 o'clock, of Bright's disease, aged 70 years, 1 month and 22 days. He had been in poor health for some time, but was only confined to his bed a few days.

He was a son of Asher and Frances Woodmansee, pioneer settlers of Jackson county and was born in Grassy Fork township on what is now known as the Tormoehlen farm, December 31, 1851. He was united in marriage to Miss Eldora Wayman November 23, 1873. To this union were born six children, Robert, Bruce and Maude having died in childhood, and Joe in 1912. Those who survive him are Mrs. G. W. Heller, Mrs. G. F. Schwein and Scott Woodmansee, all of this place. He was one of twelve children, all of whom have preceded him to the grave, with the exception of one sister, Miss Ida Woodmansee, of Louisville, Ky.

Funeral services were conducted at the home of Mrs. Schwein Saturday morning at ten o'clock, Rev. F. M. Moore, pastor of the Presbyterian church, officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
