Workman—W. R. Workman, age 71, passed away at his home in Brownstown Tuesday evening at 5 o'clock. He had been in failing health for about two years and for the past two months had been confined to his bed.

Mr. Workman was born at Marco, Indiana, June 7, 1862. He was married at Mitchell to Miss Sarah Neidfer March 12, 1884, where they resided for several years before moving to Brownstown. Later they returned to Mitchell, moving back to Brownstown a few years ago.

Deceased followed the occupation of a railroader and for forty years he was employed as section foreman on the Baltimore and Ohio railroad. Because of the nature of his occupation he came in contact with many people on his section of the road. He was of a quiet disposition and was devoted to his home and family. He was an industrious and honest citizen and commanded the respect of a wide circle of friends.

Surviving besides the widow are two children, Howard O. Workman, of Phoenix, Arizona; Mrs. Will Richards, of Brownstown, and one grandson, William Richards, of Brownstown. He was a member of the Brownstown Baptist church and the Brotherhood of Railway Trainmen.
