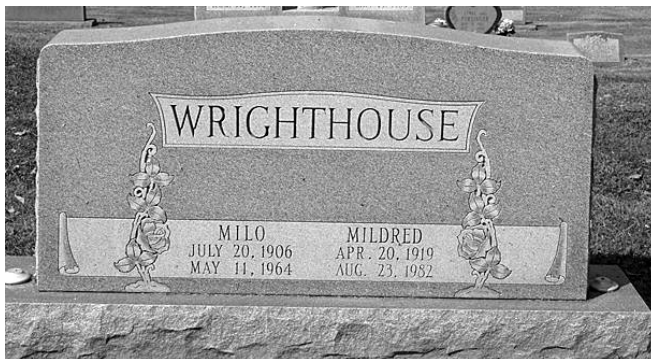

Mildred L. Lucas, 63, of 604 Bloomington Road, Brownstown, died at 10:12 p.m. Monday at St. Vincent Hospital, Indianapolis. She had been ill one month.

Mrs. Lucas was a member of the Brownstown United Methodist Church and was formerly employed by The Peoples Bank in Brownstown.
