Rural Medora Girl Killed In Car Crash Early Monday

Angela L. Young, 17, Medora Rt. 1, died in a single-vehicle traffic accident at approximately 1 a.m.

Monday, Feb. 22, on U.S. 50 just west of St. Rd. 135.

Trooper Bob Hedger of the Indiana State Police at Seymour said a 1979 Audi driven by Miss Young went off the road and flipped end-over-end several times. He said the driver was thrown through the windshield. Brownstown police assisted in investigating the accident.

Miss Young was a senior at Brownstown Central High School, where she was a four-year member of the drill team and track team. She had been accepted to enter Ball State University next fall. She was a member of the Landmark Missionary Baptist Church, Bedford.

A lifelong resident of Jackson County, she was born Feb. 23, 1970, in Jackson County to Jack and Cathy C. Young, Medora.

Survivors include one brother: Craig Young, Louisville, Ky.; her paternal grandparents: Mr. and Mrs. Ralph Young, Medora; her maternal grandparents: Mr. and Mrs. Frank Fee Sr., Washington; and several aunts and uncles.

Funeral services will begin at 2 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 24, at the Spurgeon Funeral Home, Brownstown. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
