Alice Bryan Zaring, 90, of Seymour died at 6:20 p.m. Wednesday, April 10, 1996, at Lutheran Community Home in Seymour, after being in failing health for several years.

Mrs. Zaring was a school-teacher in Fairfield, Ill., and at Cox School and Clear-spring School. She attended First Presbyterian Church in Seymour and was a member and past president (locally and of the Ninth Precinct) of American Legion Post 89 Ladies Auxiliary, and was a member of Jackson County Farm Bureau.

Born July 31, 1905, in Rus-sell Chapel, she was a daugh-ter of John James and Bertha Russell Bryan. On June 11, 1927, in Jackson County, she married Roswald A. Zaring, who died May 1, 1976.

Survivors include a son, Richard L. Zaring, Scipio; and two sisters, Laura Mae Goss-

man, Brownstown; and Helen June Heller, Columbus.
