Dr. Byron K. Zaring, 72, 1901 Taylor Road, Columbus, formerly of Brownstown, died at 12:57 a.m. Wednesday at the Bartholomew County Hospital. He had been ill for several years.

Dr. Zaring retired in 1971 after 36 years of medical practice in Columbus.

In 1930, he graduated from the Indiana University School of Medicine. He began his general practice in Columbus in 1935.

Dr. Zaring served in the Army Medical Corps for four years during World War II before returning to Columbus where he specialized in surgery.

He was active with the American Cancer Society and was a member of the American and Indiana State Medical Associations. He also was past president and past secretary of the Bartholomew-Brown County Medical Association.

Dr. Zaring was a member of the First United Presbyterian Church in Columbus.

Born April 10, 1906, in Scott County, he was the son of the late Dr. Philip A. and Alsey Ingram Zaring.

On Aug. 4, 1931, he was married in Southport to the former Florence Brewer, who preceded him in death on July 16, 1974.

Survivors include a son, Philip Zaring, Ames, Iowa; a sister, Mrs. Leonora Marford, Indianapolis; and two grandsons.

A sister, Rosenelle, and two brothers, Wendell and Roswald, all preceded him in death.

Services will be conducted at 1 p.m. Saturday from the First United Presbyterian Church in Columbus with Dr. Warner M. Bailey, pastor, officiating.

Graveside services will be conducted at 3 p.m. Saturday from the Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
