## Local Youth Dies Of Crash Injuries

### John Zaring Succumbs In North Carolina

Companion Still In  
Hospital—Accident  
Occurred on Curve  
Sunday—Rites Set

Critical injuries sustained Sunday afternoon in an automobile accident in North Carolina, proved fatal early today to John Roswald Zaring, 23, son of Mr. and Mrs. Roswald A. Zaring, Seymour R2.

The well known local youth, who sustained severe chest injuries in the crash, died at the Davis Hospital in Statesville, N. C., where he was taken for treatment after the accident. His companion, Max Wayne Noblitt, 21, Seymour R4, is receiving treatment in the hospital for his injuries sustained in the crash, which include a broken nose, a broken arm, a fractured jaw and the loss of several teeth. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Arch Noblitt.

**Funeral Saturday**  
Funeral services for Mr. Zaring will be conducted at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon from the Voss Mortuary. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown. Friends may call at the Voss Mortuary after 7 o'clock Friday night.
