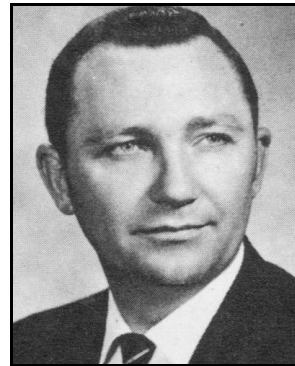

Dean L. Zike, 84, of Brownstown, passed away on Thursday, March 5, 2015 at his home at 12:10 pm.

He was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church. He and his wife Jane operated the Frostop Drive-in in Brownstown for several years. He was also a member of the American Legion and the VFW.

He had graduated from the Freetown High School and received his Bachelor's Degree in Education from Indiana Central College and his Master's Degree from Indiana University. He taught and coached basketball at Freetown, Clearspring, Cortland, Heltonville and Jennings County. After teaching, he was an agent for Farm Bureau Insurance. He retired in 1995 and he was agent of the year in 1984 and 1985.

He was a combat veteran of the Korean War. He was a Sgt. in the 27th Regiment, 25th Division from 1952 to 1952 while he was in the Army. He enjoyed watching college basketball on tv and was a Cincinnati Red's fan.

Born December 20, 1930 in Freetown, he was a son of Dayton Henry and Bertha Iva (Fields) Zike. On February 14, 1952 in Brownstown, he married Jane Mullen who survives.
