Brownstown Man Is Dead

Orville Irvin Alexander, age twenty, well known Brownstown young man, died at 1:30 o'clock this morning at Schneck Memorial Hospital where he was admitted about a week ago suffering with acute appendicitis. An operation which was performed revealed that the appendix had ruptured and general peritonitis developed, which caused his death.

Mr. Alexander had been operator of the projector at the Royal Theater, Brownstown, for the past three years and was one of the best known young men of Brownstown. He was born in the county seat on September 17, 1918, the son of Oscar and Elsie Bradley Alexander, who survives.

He was married on September 18, 1938, at Scottsburg to Ruby Pennington, who survives.

Besides the widow and parents, he is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Virginia Stratton, of Indianapolis and Miss Dorothy Alexander, of Brownstown.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon from the Brownstown Christian Church. Burial in Fairview Cemetery.
