Mrs. Dora Allen, 37, Dies at Brownstown

Mrs. Dora Allen, age thirty-seven, died Monday morning at her home on Brownstown R2, south of Tampico, after an illness which confined her to her bed only two days.

Mrs. Allen was born August 7, 1907 in Manchester, Ky., the daughter of Delbert D. and Ellen Baker Coldiron. She was married November 27, 1931 at Mount Vernon, Ky., to Richard Allen, who survives.

Mrs. Allen was a war worker and had been employed by the local plant of Noblitt-Sparks Industries, Inc., from March, 1943 until the first part of this month. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church and had a wide circle of friends who mourn her death.

Besides the husband, she is survived by a daughter, Barbara, age twelve, at home, and one brother, William Edward Coldiron, Brownstown R2.
