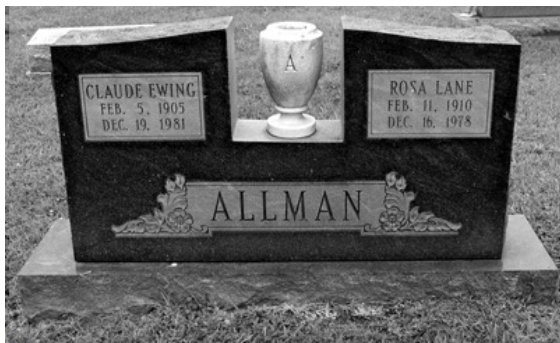

Claude E. Allman Sr., 76, of Hoosier Christian Village died at 8:50 p.m. Saturday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital.

Mr. Allman worked at Keiffer Paper Mills in Brownstown for 20 years, and retired from Cummins Engine Co. in Columbus in 1962.

Mr. Allman was a member of Brownstown United Methodist Church, Washington Lodge 13 Free and Accepted Masons, the Order of the Eastern Star 464 of Brownstown, and Eagles Lodge 462 of Seymour.

He was born in Jackson County on Feb. 5, 1905, to Alexander and Eliza Meeks Allman.
