## Kenneth Martin Amos

June 18, 1927 - Jan. 26, 2004

Kenneth Martin "Grease Monkey" Amos, 76, Brownstown, died at 2:24 a.m. Monday, Jan. 26, 2004, at Schneck Medical Center, Seymour.

Mr. Amos was a member of the White River Chapel, Seymour, and a veteran of the U.S. Air Force. He was a self-employed diesel mechanic and a member of the American Legion. He also was president of the Spirit of 76 CB Club from 1976 to 1988. He was a member of Temple Texas Motorcycle Club.
