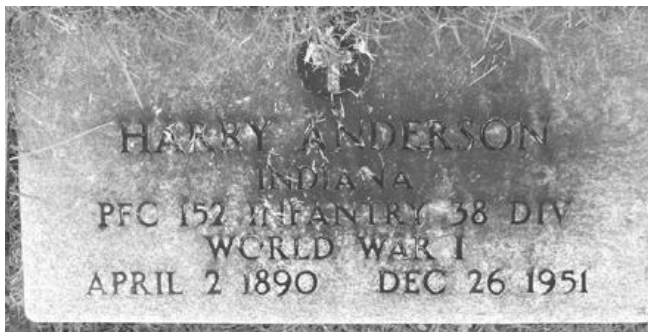

Harry Anderson, Brownstown, Dies

Harry Anderson, 61, who was engaged in the real estate business in Brownstown, died Wednesday afternoon at Schneck Memorial Hospital here. He had been ill for the past five days.

Mr. Anderson was a life-long resident of Brownstown, where he was born April 2, 1890, the son of the late Oscar and Carrie Horstman Anderson. He was married November 28, 1918, in Brownstown to Pearl Miller, who survives.

Mr. Anderson was a veteran of World War I and was a member of Camp Jackson Post No. 112, American Legion, of Brownstown. He also was a member of the Disabled Veterans of Indianapolis. He also was a member of the Brownstown Methodist Church. He had been engaged in the real estate business in Brownstown for a number of years and was widely known. A host of friends throughout the county mourns his death.

Besides the widow, he is survived by two children: Sgt. Francis H. Anderson, of Watertown, N. Y. and Mrs. Mabel Beaty, of Brownstown. A sister, Mrs. R. L. Kuzmaul, of South Bend, and four grandchildren also survive.
