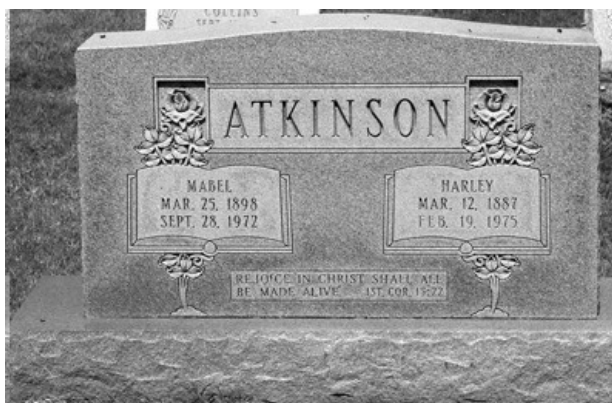

Harley Atkinson

Harley C. Atkinson, 87, of Brownstown, died Wednesday, Feb. 19, at the home of a daughter in Tuscon, Ariz.

A native of Martin County, Mr. Atkinson was born March 12, 1887, to the late Palmer and Emily Atkinson. On Aug. 19, 1919, at Shoals, he married the former Mabel Jones, who preceded him in death on Sept. 28, 1972.

Mr. Atkinson, a resident of Brownstown for 35 years, was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church and the American Legion. He was a veteran of World War I.
