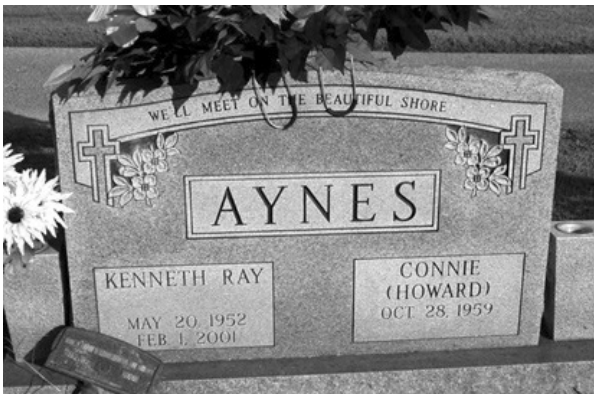

Kenneth R. Aynes, 48, Paris Crossing, died at 3 :30 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 1, at Indiana University Medical Center in Indianapolis. He had been failing in health two years.
