## Crushed to Death By Bale of Paper

BROWNSTOWN — Killed instantly Wednesday morning when an 1,800-pound bale of paper fell onto him from a hoist at Kieffer Paper Mill at Ewing

was Lawrence Thomas Babbs, 51, of Brownstown. He had been employed at the mill 21 years.

The bale was being moved from one location to another by the hoist.
