**Rites Held Saturday
For B. P. Baker—Dies
At Hospital Thursday**

Funeral rites were held Saturday afternoon from the Zabel Funeral Home for B. P. Baker, well-known retired farmer of this area, who died Thursday morning at the Jackson county hospital. He had been ill three weeks.

The Rev. Raymond Gaiter, pastor of the Rock of Light Tabernacle, Ewing, was in charge of the last rites. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery.

A native of Clay county, Kentucky, Mr. Baker was born June 17, 1886, a son of the late Daniel and America Baker.
