C. Ball Dies, Rites Set Wednesday

Clarence B. Ball, 79, 908 West Spring street, Brownstown, died at 4:50 p. m. Sunday at Schneck Memorial Hospital. He had been ill for about five months but seriously only for the past three weeks.

A retired lumber dealer and contractor, Mr. Ball had been affiliated with the Ball Lumber Company for many years and had operated the firm from 1940 until his retirement in 1963.

He was a 50-year member of Washington Lodge 13, Free and Accepted Masons, of Brownstown, and also of the Brownstown Knights of Pythias lodge.

Mr. Ball was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church and a director of the People's Bank of Brownstown.

He was a member of Seymour Lodge 462, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks and of Seymour Aerie 655, Fraternal Order of Eagles.

Born Sept. 12, 1893, in Brownstown, he was the son of the late William C. and Alice M. Humphrey Ball. On May 24, 1941 in Seymour, he married Alice Lyons, who survives.

In addition to the widow, he is survived by two brothers, Kenneth Ball, of Brownstown, and Dr. Charles Ball, of Plainfield; four sisters, the Misses Stella, Grace and Esther Ball and Mrs. George H. Conner, all of Brownstown.

One brother, Leon, preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p. m. Wednesday from the Zabel Funeral Home, Brownstown, with the Rev. Evan Bolejack, pastor of the Brownstown Christian Church, officiating. Burial in Fairview Cemetery in Brownstown.
