## Rites Held Tues. For Mrs. W. C. Ball

Mrs. Elizabeth Alice Ball, age 79, one of Brownstown's well known women, passed away at her home here Saturday night at 8:50 o'clock following an illness of five weeks, due to a cerebral hemorrhage.

Funeral services were conducted at the Christian church Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock with the Rev. John U. Phelps, pastor, in charge, assisted by the Rev. Glen O. Mills, of Cincinnati. Burial was made in Fairview cemetery.

Mrs. Ball was born to James and Mary C. Sample Humphrey in Washington county, Indiana, on December 6, 1866. She was married in Brownstown to William C. Ball on July 25, 1886, who preceded her in death in 1940. Mr. and Mrs. Ball celebrated their golden wedding anniversary in July, 1936. She was essentially a home woman and she made the home a shrine for her children and grandchildren. She was a devout member of the Christian church and Missionary Society and leaves many friends to mourn her death.

Surviving are three sons, Clarence Ball, Sgt. Kenneth H. Ball and Major Charles L. Ball, all of Brownstown; one son, William Leon Ball, died in 1937; three daughters, Misses Stella, Grace Ann and Esther, all at home, and Mrs. George H. Conner, of Brownstown. Also surviving are seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
