

BALL-Mrs. Eliza A. Ball, wife of James M. Ball, died at her home at this place Tuesday morning, April 12, 1910, aged 70 years, 1 month and 27 days. She had been an invalid for about six years, but was taken worse about a week ago and all that medical aid could do for ther was done, but to no avail.

Deceased was born at Madison, Ind., February 15, 1840. She was united in marriage to Mr. Ball October 9th, 1860. To their union were born six children, of whom four are living. They moved to Brownstown about thirty years ago. She united with the Methodist church at Madison early in life and afterward became a member of the Methodist church at this place.

Mrs. Ball was of a quiet disposition and was an earnest christian lady. Although not physically strong, she never failed to render service to those who appealed to her tender heart, whether it was her family, her friends or her neighbors. Her death will not only be mourned by her husband and children, but by a host of friends. She was a devoted wife, a fond mother and a good neighbor.
