Grace Ball, B'town Woman, Dies, Rites Set

Miss Grace A. Ball, 79, 718 West Walnut street, Brownstown, died at 11:50 p. m. Wednesday at the Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital after an illness of five months.

Miss Ball was a retired book-keeper with the Citizens State Bank in Brownstown and the Ball Lumber Company. She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary and Psi Iota Xi.

Born Aug. 31, 1896, in Brownstown, she was the daughter of the late William C. and Eliza Alice Humphrey Ball.
