Mrs. Golda Banks, 56, Brownstown, Expires

Mrs. Golda Banks, 56, widely known resident of Brownstown and wife of Dan Banks, died early this morning at the Kentucky Baptist Hospital, Louisville, where she had been receiving treatment. She had been in failing health for several months and had been seriously ill since about January 1.

Mrs. Banks was born October 24, 1896, in Brownstown township, two miles south of Brownstown, the daughter of the late Ed E. and Effie Miller Shelton. She was married in October, 1919, at Brownstown to Dan Banks and had lived all of her life in and near Brownstown. She was a member of the Brownstown Baptist Church and was active in all of its organizations, particularly the missionary society, as long as her health permitted. Well known and well liked throughout the vicinity, Mr. Banks was highly respected and her death is mourned by a host of friends.

Besides the husband, she is survived by one son, Jerry Dale Banks, at home; two brothers: Forrest Shelton, of Brownstown and Price Shelton, of Louisville, Ky., and two sisters: Mrs. Ed Boley and Mrs. Lawrence Reedy, both of Brownstown. One son preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home, Brownstown, with the Rev. Leighton Norris, pastor of the Brownstown Baptist Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
