Jesse Banks, Owen Township, Succumbs

Jesse Banks, 87, retired Owen township farmer, died this morning at the home of a nephew, Kenneth Wineinger, 535 West Fourth street. Although Mrs. Banks, who had resided in Jackson county virtually his entire life, had been in failing health all winter, he had been seriously ill for only three weeks and bedfast for three days. He resided on Brownstown R1, west of Brownstown.

Born in August, 1868, the son of the late Thomas and Nancy Ann Sutton Banks, Mr. Banks was married on December 29, 1891, in this county to Florence Beavers, who preceded him in death on June 29, 1955.

Although no children were born to the union, the late Mr. and Mrs. Banks reared three nephews in their home: Kenneth Wineinger and Meredith Wineinger, of this city, and Ralph Wineinger, Brownstown R1.

Mr. Banks was widely known throughout western Jackson county and he leaves many friends to mourn his death. He was a member of the Kurtz Methodist Church.

Survivors, in addition to the three nephews whom he reared, include one half-brother, Elsworth Brown, Brownstown R1, and several nieces and nephews. Five brothers and sisters preceded Mr. Banks in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home in Brownstown, with the Rev. Ralph Adkins, pastor of First Evangelical United Brethren Church here, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
