## Heart Attack Fatal To Irvin Barkman— Rites Held Sunday

A second heart attack, suffered within an hour, proved fatal about 9:30 o'clock Thursday night to Irvin William Barkman, well-known resident of the Tampico vicinity.

Mr. Barkman suffered his first attack while at work at the Seymour plant of Arvin Industries, Inc., about 8:30 o'clock and was rushed to the Jackson county hospital. He suffered a second attack about forty-five minutes later which proved fatal.

Born in Brownstown township, August 23, 1915, Mr. Barkman was an only son of William L. and Lydia Rorig Barkman, of

Brownstown. His father, now retired, was Brownstown marshal for many years.

He was married on April 12, 1940, to Lacondia Pruett, at Muncie.

Mrs. Barkman, who survives, is a member of the Tampico Elementary School teaching staff.

Also surviving are two sons, William Lee Barkman, of Brownstown, and Irvin Dale Barkman and a daughter, Vivian Barkman, at home, a granddaughter and one sister, Mrs. Travis B. (Margaret) Carter, of Seymour.

Mr. Barkman was an active layman of the Tampico Baptist Church and funeral rites were held there Sunday afternoon, in charge of the pastor, the Rev. Joe Hawkins.

Interment was in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
