Mr. Barnes Dies During Operation

MEDORA — Lonnie R. Barnes, father of George W. Barnes of South Airport road south of Columbus, died during emergency ulcer surgery Sunday at Dunn Memorial hospital in Bedford. He was 69 and lived at Medora.

The funeral will be conducted at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the Brownstown Baptist church by the Rev. Ernest Anderson of the church where Mr. Barnes was a member. Burial will be at Fairview cemetery in Brownstown. Persons may call now at the Winklepleck - Weesner funeral home in Brownstown and after 1 p.m. Wednesday at the church.

Mr. Barnes was born April 6, 1901, in Jackson county and was the son of Craven and Florence Lucas Barnes. He married the former Eva Collingsworth Jan. 27, 1922, and she survives.
