## WEEKLY DEATH RECORD

**Benton**—Mrs. Emma Benton, age 83, formerly of Brownstown, passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. George Boileau, at Red Oak, Iowa, Friday night following a short illness of flu and bronchitis.

The body, accompanied by her son-in-law, George Boileau, arrived here Sunday afternoon and was taken to the Wallace funeral home. On account of sickness, her daughter was unable to come.

Funeral services in charge of the Rev. Leo S. Lovell, were held at the Methodist church Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

Emily Irwin was born in Oxford, Ohio, April 29, 1846. There she grew to womanhood and attended what was then known as "Oxford Female College." Later she moved with her parents to Missouri, where in 1868 she was married to Charles W. Benton. After living at Laclede, Missouri, for several years, they moved to Brownstown, where Mrs. Benton spent most of her life. After the death of her husband six years ago, she went to Red Oak, Iowa, where she made her home with her daughter.
